HOW TO TAKE PROPER CARE OF YOUR NEW POOL

- 1. **NO BRUSHING** POOL FOR THE FIRST FOUR (4) DAYS
- 2. **NO WALKING IN POOL** AFTER WORKERS HAS FINISHED THE POOL
- 3. NO CHEMICALS FOR THE FIRST THREE (3) DAYS
- 4. NO SELF CLEANING MACHINES SUCH AS CRAWLER OR BARRACUDAS FOR AT LEAST SIX (6) WEEKS
- 5. **DO NOT STOP THE FLOW OF WATER** ONCE YOU START LOADING THE POOL UNTIL IT REACHES THE CENTER OF THE TILE OR WATERLINE OF TILE. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN A RING IN AROUND THE INSIDE OF THE POOL
- 6. PRESERVE ACID LEVEL HIGH FOR THE FIRST TWO (2)

 MONTHS. THE POOL WILL CALCIFY IF THE ACID LEVEL IS NOT

 KEPT HIGH ENOUGH. CALCIFYING OCCURS FROM THE

 CHEMICALS CLASHING INSTEAD OF DILUTING.

7. SIGNS OF CALCIFYING

WHITE ROUGH RESIDUE DEVELOPS ON TILES, LIGHTS AND POOL SURFACE. CAN ALSO CAUSE BAD SPOTS IN THE POOL, CRACKING AND DISCOLORATION OF THE FINISH.
